Community Clean-Up Day is May 29

Residents and business operators are asked to make a special effort to do their part and contribute their time and support and show pride in your community in this special clean-up effort. On this day as well a school bottle drive (TEAM-TEEN) is being carried out to support school related activities.

Flushing of Town water lines: May 17 to May 28

Commencing on May 17th for a 2 week period Council will be flushing out its water lines. This is in part related to the process of commissioning our new water tower and pump house which are now operational. Flushing will start at the Front and work outwards to the Lighthouse Road, Quigley's Line, Main St, Ridge and Range areas, Davidson Ave, and Courthouse Hill. During this two week period residents may experience periods of low water pressure and/or discolouration of their water. The Town apologizes in advance to residents for any inconvenience they may experience during this time of system maintenance.

Clean up Month-May 18 to June 18

Council's designated clean up month commences on May 18. You are encouraged to make a special effort to clean out surplus junk items and waste and place it on the roadside in an orderly manner as per our guidelines. Please identify for special attention car wrecks and used car parts and make arrangements for their removal
