TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY

OCTOBER 9TH, 2005

Some things in life are simply beyond our understanding. We may call them "mysteries," but too often that word has stopped wonder instead of starting it. Today's readings want to push us beyond easy understanding into wonder. Isaiah portrays a time when "the Lord God will wipe away the tears from every face" - a profound promise, but one that flies in the face of so much daily evidence. Paul describes amazing freedom: "I have learned the secret of being well fed and of going hungry, of living in abundance and of being in need." Who of us could say the same? And Jesus tells a multilayered story: feast, ingratitude, wrathful destruction, amazing invitation, and finally mute puzzlement and condemnation. Too much altogether is going on to make neat sense of-which is the point. Isaiah, Paul and Jesus all speak not so much to inform their hearers as to change them.
