RAISING THE ROOF: Over the last three years we have been doing “patch up jobs” to stop the leaks and prevent further damage to the gyproc walls in the Parish Centre & Marian Chapel. A complete engineering assessment was done by a professional firm which recommended the Parish Centre be re-shingled immediately and the whole church roof should be re-shingled within three to five years. Having finished the ice and water shield and shingles on the Parish Centre, we still had leaks on half of the east and west wings of the main church. This has now been completed and the rain storm leaks have stopped. The final bill has not yet been received, but we estimate the work done will cost the parish almost \$60,000.00. We used enough shingles to cover ten regular size houses. We will be taking out an interest free loan for the cost with a plan to have it all repaid over a five year period. We are really encouraged by the instance response from families who are making a donation of \$50.00 to cover the cost of one bundle of shingles plus the felt nails and cement used in this mammoth undertaking. If you would like to make that kind of offering (\$50.00) in memory of your family members, it will gratefully be received.

REFLECTION:

FIRST READING: *Isaiah 66. 10-14*

I will extend prosperity to her like a river. Isaiah envisions a restored Jerusalem as a nursing mother who nourishes and comforts her children. God's holy city is a place of rejoicing and life. Today, the church is called to be the maternal face of God, nourishing and comforting her members.

SECOND READING: *Galatians 6. 14-18*

I carry the marks of Jesus branded on my body. Paul proclaims that the cross of Christ makes all things new. The cross brings life, not death, for the cross transforms humankind's relationship to the world. Through the cross Paul was set free from the narrow constraints of worldly success and set free to live for Christ.

GOSPEL: *Luke 10. 1-12, 17-20*

Your peace will rest upon them. The disciples' mission of proclaiming the dawn of God's reign was met with great success. The power of Jesus' name enabled them even to expel demons. Yet, Jesus tempers their jubilation with a call to rejoice in a greater success: the inscription of their names in heaven.
