REFLECTION:

FIRST READING: Proverbs 8: 22-31

Before the beginning of the earth, wisdom had already been bought forth.

The book of Proverbs, known for its collection of wise sayings, speaks today not of a distillation of human wisdom but a bold revelation concerning the wisdom of God. God's wisdom, begotten before all ages, was his master craftsman in the creation of all things, rejoicing and delighting in his presence. Eternal wisdom delights in the creation that he would be called to redeem in the fullness of time.

SECOND READING: Romans 5: 1-5

God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Spirit.

Paul announces to the Romans two causes for their boasting: faith and suffering. Christians boast of their faith, for they have received the gift of righteousness from God. Christians may boast of their suffering, for it leads us to continue to place all our hope in the gift of salvation communicated to us in the power of the Holy Spirit.

GOSPEL: John 16: 12-15

All that the father has is mine, and the Spirit will take what is mine and declare it to you. Jesus tells his disciples that the promised gift of the Holy Spirit will guide them in to all truth and glorify Jesus. The truth is not a series of verifiable propositions or claims about reality, but a relationship with the one who is God's truth. We are invited to share in a relationship with the one who exists in the communion of love that is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
