REFLECTION:

FIRST READING: *Wisdom 11: 22-12.2*

You are merciful to all, for you love all things that exist.

God is patient and sustains us in being so that we might have the opportunity to repent and return to the embrace on his love. God admonishes us that we might see the error of our ways and learn to abstain from evil through a deepened trust in his love.

SECOND READING: *Thessalonians 1: 11-2.2*

May the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ be glorified in you, and you in him.

As Paul prays that God will bring completion to the good he has inaugurated in the lives of Thessalonians, he counsels them to patience as they await the Lord's return. The present period of building upon the foundation of God's kingdom ought to be their principal concern and ours as well.
